Due to limited available personnel during Covid, the Christmas at Sea program had to make adjustments and change in order to continue supporting seafarers. Our youth and their families are invited to assist once again.



All items this year are being placed in a **one-gallon sealed plastic bag** (no shoe boxes). Then add some of the following, depending on your budget and space: **warm gloves or warm socks, hand warmers, pad and pen, flash drive, small, sealed gender-neutral toiletries. Combs, toothbrushes,** etc. **should be individually sealed in original packaging,** for the protection of the seafarers. 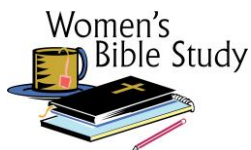
### SOCIAL MINISTRY
