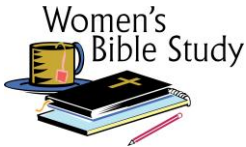


Virtual Crop Walk Results Way to go Zion! We have raised \$910 for the Crop Walk to help fight hunger locally and globally. Thank you!
